9th Annual Visual Arts Show

Saturday, March 17, 2018

Registration and entrance fees are due Friday, March 2, 2018.

Art is to be submitted Monday, March 12 or Tuesday, March 13.

For CVCS students in grades 1-12.

The purpose of this annual event is to give our students in grades 1-12 an opportunity to share and develop their God-given artistic talents in the visual arts. Categories for this event will be Dry Medium (pencil or colored pencil/graphite drawings, chalk pastels), Wet Medium (watercolors or acrylics/oil), Photography (people/animals, still life, landscape, or black and white), and Graphic Art (digital illustration or digitally enhanced image). **Please note – Registration form and entrance fees must be turned in to any campus office by Friday, March 2. Late Registrations and fees will not be accepted.** Art is to be submitted Monday, March 12 or Tuesday, March 13. Judging will take place the day before the Show.

The 9th Annual Visual Arts Show will be held on Saturday, March 17, 2018 from 6:00 – 7:30 p.m. in the Auditorium at the Secondary Campus. During this free event, visitors may walk through the Art Show with music provided by Cole Valley Christian students and desserts for sale by costumed High School Drama Department actors. First and second place winners in each Art Show category and age group will be announced at 7:00 p.m. All artwork must be taken home after the Art Show Saturday night.

Registration Fee and Entry Limit: Registration forms and fees of \$10 for the first entry, \$5 for additional entries must be received by Friday, March 2. No more than three entries will be accepted per student.

ARTWORK AND PHOTOGRAPHY SUBMISSIONS MUST BE CURRENT – WITHIN THE LAST YEAR.

Category Descriptions

Dry Medium

- Pencil/Colored Pencil - Drawings created entirely with colored pencils. The addition of ink or other media is not permitted.
- Graphite - Black and white drawings created entirely with graphite pencils. The addition of ink or other media is not permitted.
- Chalk Pastels - Drawings created entirely with chalk pastels (not chalk) on medium-appropriate paper. The addition of other media is not permitted.

Wet Medium

- Watercolor - Paintings created with specifically watercolor paints on medium-appropriate paper. The addition of ink or other media is not permitted.
- Acrylic Paint - Paintings created with specifically acrylic paints on canvas or medium-appropriate paper. The addition of other media is not permitted.

Photography

- People or Animals - The subject of the image is an animal or human. Does not include plant life. The image captures the whole body or just aspects of the subject (feet, hands, portraiture, etc.).
- Still Life - The significant point of the image is an inanimate object (plant life, instruments, buildings, macro, etc.). Can include minimal aspects of human or animal interaction (i.e. hands playing guitar).
- Landscape - The image should include a foreground, midground, and background (nature landscape, buildings, etc.).
- Black and White - Image must be completely monochromatic. Includes single-color processing, sepia tones, or black and white images.

Graphic Art (must be printed and mounted for submission. No digital submissions will be accepted).

- Digital Illustration - Composite images created in vector-based software. The design may include typography and layout.
- Digitally Enhanced Image - An image enhanced in raster-based software. The image should create a hyperrealistic effect or appearance. Examples of hyperrealism include HDR, text overlay, and composite image.

Specifications for Submissions:

Size and paper type:

- For all grades, **paintings and drawings** must be no larger than 400 square inches (up to 20"x20") and must be on medium-appropriate paper (canvas, art, or construction). Notebook paper is not acceptable art paper.
- **Photographs and graphic art** must be 8x10 inches or larger (up to 20"x20") mounted on foam core. The mounting may not exceed more than 1 inch around the print. Foam core used for displaying photography is available at your photographic or art supplier. Prints may be mounted in a vertical or horizontal position. Foam core thickness should not exceed ¼". **NO PHOTOGRAPH OR GRAPHIC ART WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS MOUNTED.**

- We do not accept: three dimensional art, prints in frames, or art mounted on wood, glass, plastic, or Formica.

PLEASE NOTE: If work submitted does not adhere to the above, it will be disqualified from judging.

Labeling:

- For all grades, please make sure your first and last name, phone number, grade, category, and title of piece are clearly printed on the **BACK** of your submission. Titles are required. For example:

Susie Jones 208-947-1212 4 th Grade Photography "Winter Wonderland"
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- **Do not** label or sign the FRONT of your artwork.

Display:

- All art must be mounted in a sturdy way to avoid damage and allow it to stand upright in an easel for display.
- **NO FRAMED ARTWORK.**

Delivery of Art Submissions:

All art submissions must be delivered Monday, March 12 or Tuesday, March 13 by 3:20 p.m. Late entries will not be accepted.

Judging Criteria:

See the Judging forms on our website (ColeValleyChristian.org > Arts > Visual Art Show 2018) for the judging criteria by category. Although the same judging forms are used for all grade levels, age will be considered in the individual judging.

Awards:

- 1st and 2nd place prizes will be awarded by grade levels and categories.
- Awards will be announced at the Visual Arts Show, Saturday, March 17, at 7:00 p.m.
