Cole Valley Christian Schools (CVCS) is an Early Childhood Education through 12th grade private, Christian school with just over 940 students on two campuses. The Secondary Campus, located in Meridian, Idaho, houses grades 7-12. The four-year high school's current enrollment is approximately 290 students. Founded in 1972, the school is a ministry of Cole Community Church with a student body representing over 100 churches from throughout the Treasure Valley.
