## LUNCH ACCOUNTS

- Effective **Tuesday 5/1**, no lunch purchases will be allowed if your students lunch account is in the negative, please plan accordingly. If you are unsure of what the balance is on your students account you can:
  - Log into ParentsWeb on the CVCS website
  - Click on Family Information
  - Family Billing at the bottom right hand corner will show you how much money is left on your students account (**please note that a – (minus sign) represents a positive amount**)
  - The detail tab will give you a breakdown of money that has been deposited and a specific list of what money has been spent on and when. If you have more than one student, this will also show what each child has purchased individually.

- Any student that still has an unpaid balance at the end of the year will not receive their yearbook, diploma, or report card until their balance is paid.

- If you have recommitted your student(s) for the 2018-2019 school year, the Recommittment Fee (\$140 per student) is due on or before **Tuesday, 5/1**. ### **SUMMER SCHOOL INFORMATION**

  - All Secondary students (grades 7-12) who failed any required class (fell below 60%).
  - All Secondary students (grades 7-11) *who did not pass math with the minimum 70% required to advance* (unless retaking the course next year).
- Summer school is also available for:
  - Any high school students who wish to remediate prior low grades for transcript purposes.
- Options:
