Job Responsibilities:

- Administers the middle and high school band, string ensemble, and color guard programs. Programs include marching band, pep band, string ensemble, concert band, jazz band, solo/small ensembles, orchestra, fall color guard, and spring winter guard.
- Plan, organize, direct summer secondary band, string ensemble, and color guard clinics. This includes the summer band camp for marching band and color guard.
- Plan and organize concerts, festivals, and other public performances.
- Select, direct, supervise, and coordinate the work of instrumental music department coaches, volunteers, and clinicians.
- Plan rehearsal activities and performances of the instrumental music department ensembles including all color guard and winter guard events, concerts, performances, parades, and competitions.
- Maintain accurate inventory of all music, equipment, and uniforms used by the instrumental music department and color guard.
- Be responsible for maintenance, repair, overhaul, and storage of all music, equipment, and uniforms.
- Plan, supervise, and administer any music festival, competitions, and tours.
- Choose all music to be performed by each of the ensembles including winter guard.
- Submit titles, scores, and recordings as required for competitions and performance licensure.
- Rehearse and prepare instrumental music ensembles and color guard to perform at varsity home football games, selected basketball games, school assemblies.
- Plan, organize, and direct try-outs for drum majors and any special units.
- Design football game field show competition performances (drill and choreography), parade (drill and choreography), winter guard show and all other instrumental music department performances.

- Supervise and direct all rehearsals and performances of the CVCS Instrumental Music Department ensembles and color guard.
- Participate in local competitive and community events, to be the light in the community (Luke 11:33).

Qualifications:

- Evidence of a teachable heart, a humble and gentle spirit, and an ability to “correct, rebuke, and encourage” in love.
- A unifier who “makes every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace” while working with others to accomplish our mission.
- Excellent communication and relational skills with students and adults.
- A strong desire and demonstrated ability to work as a member of a team.
- Leadership and vision: Always striving for improvement and helping others in that improvement process.
