Responsibilities:

- Drives school bus to transport teams to athletic events primarily on weekday afternoons and evenings, with occasional events on Saturdays.

- Complies with local traffic regulations.
- Reports delays or accidents.
- Completes trip and inspection logs at the beginning and end of each shift and reports discrepancies and concerns.
- Cleans interior of bus after each trip.
- Occasionally assists with cleaning of exterior of bus.
- Communicates needed repairs and/or preventive maintenance to the Director of Facilities and Safety, and transports bus to vendor shop as directed.
- Maintains order among students and reports any behavior problems to the activity advisor.
- Assists students with baggage as needed and able.

- A testimony of faith in Jesus Christ.
- Desire to invest in and disciple students in their relationship with the Lord.
- Be spiritually mature with competence in dealing with student disciplinary issues.
- Class B Commercial Driver's license, or willing to obtain.
- Endorsements: passenger, school bus, air brakes; or willing to obtain
- D.O.T. Physical, or willing to obtain.
- First Aid/CPR certification, or willing to obtain
