- Oversees and submits annual Immunization Report to IRIS

- Serves as the primary contact for any health-related student concerns.
- Oversees the scheduling of annual student and/or staff medical screenings (scoliosis, mammography, etc.)
- Oversees, schedules, and maintains staff CPR/AED/First Aid compliance and trainings.
- Manages electronic health record system.
- Oversees and provides medical personnel for school sponsored events/trips:
  - Attends retreats, including overnight retreats
  - Trains staff on expectations for every event
  - o Reviews all necessary student health care plans with staff
  - Equips staff with medical records for field trips and travel
  - o Ensures First Aid kits are supplied for events/trips when necessary
